The benefits of climbing for children include the development of teamwork, self-confidence, trust, motivation and increased levels of fitness. Climbing enables children to cope with fear and stress, and encourages both self-reliance and responsibility for others. However, we are required to state that:

“The British Mountaineering Council recognises that climbing and mountaineering are activities with a danger of personal injury or death. Participants in these activities should be aware of and accept these risks and be responsible for their own actions and involvement.”
